The nearest railway station is Crowborough

The nearest bus stop is located outside the Blue Anchor pub accessible via the pavement running alongside the main road in front of the pub. The number 29 / 28 and 29X bus services run between the areas of Tunbridge Wells and Brighton.

Car Parking and Arrival

There is free parking on site for guests. The car park is located to the side of the building. It has 28 spaces and 3 disabled spaces. The car park surface to the main entrance is flat tarmac which leads up to the front door. This offers disabled access. There is a large drop off point out the front of the entrance. The car park has lamp posts around the surrounding areas to provide visibility.

Bar & Bar Area and Dining Area / Restaurant

The bar and restaurant areas are on split floors. The main restaurant is all on one level. The bar area is one step down (if needed we do have a ramp to go down to this area) and then it is one step up into our snug.

Drinks and food is all served at the table. Lighting is a mixture of natural daylight alongside wall lighting and candles throughout the bar and restaurant areas. There is background music throughout the pub. There is a mixture of wooden and laminated flooring. If you are planning a visit do give us a call to ensure we can always cater for special dietary requirements. We use where possible local suppliers and local produce. We offer full table service in all areas of the premises only.

Customer Toilets

Customer toilets are located in the bar area. There is a step down and a couple of steps up to them if you are in the main restaurant. The unisex toilet is located within the main entrance. It has a baby changing facility located here and has full wheelchair access.

Beer Garden

The beer garden and patio is open all year round and is situated behind the pub it is accessible through the restaurant or straight from the car park. The main garden is all on one level. The patio is 4 steps down. The patio and garden consists of wooden tables and benches. Located to the very back of the garden is wooden children's play area which consists of a climbing frame and slide. (Unfortunately due to current guidelines – this is not in use at present)

Additional Information

We're very dog friendly and dogs are allowed in the bar and garden areas. There are water bowls and dog biscuits available when needed.

There is free wi-fi throughout the building

All our staff receive regular training.
