



## Hygiene and Policies

Our number one priority is the safety of our guests and team, we have created an environment to ensure you can relax and enjoy your time with us.

We've upgraded our cleaning supply to meet with the latest recommended standards to kill Coronavirus. Our hygiene processes have all been reviewed with higher frequency cleaning being implemented in high traffic and touch point areas.

## Tables of up to 6 and 10pm closing

We are currently only able to accept bookings for up to 6 people (who can be from multiple households) and we'll need to ensure you're fed and watered by 10pm. We are now serving food in the evening a little earlier and will starting at 5.30pm, with last food orders being taken at 8.30pm. Last drink orders will be at 9.30pm with time being 9.45pm to ensure we can shut our doors for 10pm in line with the new government law. If you fancy a tippie to take home, we'll be offering you a variety of drinks that you can enjoy at home.

## Hand Sanitizer

When you arrive, you'll find sanitizer stations at our entrances and exits, we kindly ask you to use before entering.

## PPE

Face coverings have become mandatory by the government. We have supplied our team with face masks to ensure we deliver your meal and drinks in a safe manner. We also ask all our guests to please wear a face covering when entering and moving around the pub. This may be removed once you have sat down.

## Social Distancing

We ask everyone to comply with the current social distancing guidance of 2 metres and where not viable 1 metre is acceptable.

## Dining and Drinking with us

In the entrance and throughout the pub you will find the NHS QR code. We ask you to please download the NHS app and scan this on arrival. If you are not able to do this, please inform a member of the team and we will manually sign you in. It is all table service whether you are joining us for drinks or food. So please do not try to order at the bar we will come round to your table to take an order. No groups larger than 6 will be permitted.
